Residential Landscaping Scheme

This project was part of Nottingham City Homes' (NCH) Decent Neighbourhoods' Programme, following a £7.5m package of works carried out to insulate and refurbish three tower blocks consisting of 270 flats.

Previously this space was just a carpark, which bare verges. An abundance of wildflower turf has been used to create impact and offer opportunities for wildlife in an urban setting. Wooden posts have been used as a smarter alternative to traditional bollards, and grasses create texture.

Now the space has been adapted so that it is still a functional carpark, but also doubles as a garden for residents, with seating and impactful planting schemes.
